Thanks to the input from each of you during the academic year, a draft document has been prepared for your review. As you recall, several days of professional development activity during the fall and spring semester were devoted to discussion of the:

- **CRITICAL ISSUES BEFORE STCC**
- **FACTORS IMPACTING THE SUCCESS OF STUDENTS**
- **ISSUES IMPACTING INSTRUCTIONAL DIVISIONS**
- **COMMUNICATION CONCERNS**
- **CORE VALUES**

As the result of broad based participating input, a Strategic Focus has been developed which identifies twelve critical issues before STCC for now and the next millennium. Strategic responses were identified for each critical issue. It is now time for input once again. Please review the document and forward written comments, suggestions and/or concerns to me by July 7, 1998.
