### Apply for Admission to South Texas College.

#### Transferring to South Texas College:

- 1. Complete the Apply Texas application.
- 2. An official transcript from each institution previously attended must be submitted to the Enrollment Center.
- All new transfer students who have been accepted will have their college transcripts evaluated and applied based on this Transfer Degree Map.
- 4. Credits for courses in which a passing grade of "C" or higher was earned may be transferred from any accredited college. Developmental or other non-degree credit courses are not transferable.

#### **Application Requirements:**

- 1. Demonstrate proficiency in state mandated general knowledge content through approved means; i.e., Texas Success Initiatives (TSI), with program specific exemptions accepted.
- 2. Applicants with prior college level coursework must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5; Exceptions based on extenuating circumstances must be approved by the Dean for Math, Science, Information Technology & Bachelor Programs.
