His courses have been taught in conjunction with the Virginia State Division of Forensic Science and the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner. Investigator Newman has also instructed basic and advanced forensics at Thomas Nelson College in Virginia, equivocal death scenes at the Virginia State Division of Forensic Science and is a qualified expert in death investigation and its related forensic fields. His expertise in crime scene management through the development of protocol procedures have been adopted by several agencies across the country with great success. Inv. David Newman continues to provide aid in cold cases, 911 assessment evaluation and provides expert courtroom testimony totaling over 39 years of experience.
